Ms. Turner has started "The Last of the Mohicans in reading! The high schoolers are starting debate and public speaking.



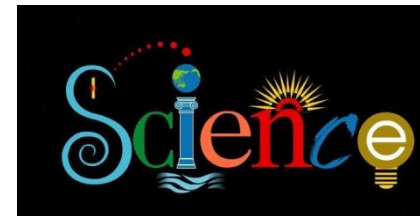
