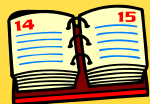

These profound words will be effective in both middle and high school classroom activities. Middle school will be creating various projects related to parts of speech as well as an introduction to creative writing. High school students will be creating their own business. Each project will assist with not only the student's academics but their self-confidence and self-esteem as well.

S.A.T. Tips

Rest – Try to get a full 8 hours of sleep each night during the week of testing. This will improve your concentration over all.

Eat – Try to eat something healthy that will fuel your brain during the test. If you stop for a fast food breakfast, consider getting a McDonald's Egg Mc Muffin instead of a sausage biscuit. If you normally skip breakfast, try to eat something... Something is better than nothing!

It's all about you – Don't worry if other kids finish faster than you... Faster doesn't mean better. Students work at different paces, and usually, students who take their time make fewer mistakes. You should take every minute that you need to do your best on each section of the test.

TIMBER! – During the test, you're going to find questions that "stump" you. Try your best to "chip away" incorrect answers. If you can eliminate one or two choices, you'll have a better chance to guess the correct answer.

'Tis NOT the season – Christmas is a wonderful time of year, but let's try NOT to "Christmas tree" any part of the test! No matter what you may have heard in the past, this test IS important to you!
